1. What are the center hours? Monday-Friday, 3:00PM-6:30PM (Closed holidays)
2. Where is the center located? Hopewell Valley YMCA, 62 South Main Street, Pennington
3. Do I need to register for the center? Yes, visit [www.hvymca.org](http://www.hvymca.org).
4. Can I come anytime, on any day? Yes, our center is open for drop-in services.
5. How can my child get to the center? Walk, bike, carpool or bus.
6. Will food be provided? Yes, we will provide a daily snack.
7. What if my child has special needs? We are open to the entire community, to support all children. If you have any specific needs or questions, please contact us.
8. Can you administer medication? Please contact us to discuss your medication needs.
9. What does it cost for my child to attend the center? Our center is FREE thanks to donations provided by businesses and community members.
10. Can my child participate in the Teen Leader program? Grades 8-12 meet monthly to help organize events in the community. Contact us if you are interested.
11. Can you make sure my child completes their homework? We are here to provide assistance as needed. Please encourage your child to budget their time appropriately.
12. Can my child use a phone? Yes, of course your child may use our center phone to contact you at any time.
13. Do you have WiFi? Yes, we have internet usage for all students. We also have a few computers, with safety controls set, for the students to use for homework or games.
14. How can my child attend the additional clubs at the center? They can join in at any time, by contacting, [hvyac.teens@hvymca.org](mailto:hvyac.teens@hvymca.org) expressing your interest. We offer daily clubs such as billiards and Magic the Gathering.
