HOPEWELL VALLEY YMCA SUMMER PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Staff and campers shall at minimum wear cloth face coverings when social distancing of 6 feet between individuals and or assigned groups cannot be maintained; except where doing so would inhibit that individual's health. Additionally, staff and campers are encouraged to wear cloth face coverings unless one of the following conditions is exhibited.

- Wearing a mask would inhibit the individuals health**
- The individual is in extreme heat outdoors**
- The individual is in water.**
- Campers will be permitted to remove masks outside, but will be encouraged to wear masks when social distancing is not achievable.**

Groups will not comingle

Activities will consist of Arts & Crafts, Science, Skills & Drills, Summer Learning, SEL activities and more.

Designated camper/group space

Spaces utilized: Cafeteria, Music Room, Gym, Art Room, Playground, Fields, Adjacent courts



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COVID-19 Illness procedure

If a child or staff member develops symptoms of COVID-19 the following steps will take place:

- Separate the person immediately and escort to medical area until the ill person can leave the facility
- Areas will be disinfected and cleaned immediately
- If symptoms persist, the ill person must call a healthcare provider. The following steps will take place while pending results:
 - HVYMCA will contact the Local Health Department and DCF Office of Licensing.
 - Positive Results
 - Implementation of the NJDOH and CDS isolation-based precautions will be administered
 - 10 day home isolation period; once period has expired, a return to camp letter from Dr. must be presented to the YMCA office prior to the return to camp.
 - Camp will operate with direction from health officials
 - If the healthcare screening returns a negative result, the previously ill person will be readmitted with a Dr.'s clearance letter.
- Communicable disease notification will go home to families asking to monitor and observe campers over the next few days.
