- 1. What are the center hours? Monday-Friday, 3:00PM-6:00PM (Closed holidays)
- 2. Where is the center located? Hopewell Valley YMCA, 62 South Main Street, Pennington
- 3. <u>Do I need to register for the center?</u> No pre-registration required. Students will sign in daily.
- 4. Can I come anytime, on any day? Feel free to stop by during operating hours.
- 5. How can my child get to the center? Walk, bike, carpool or bus.
- 6. <u>Will food be provided?</u> Food will not be provided. Students may bring snacks with them.
- 7. What if my child has special needs? We are open to the entire community, to support all children. If you have any specific needs or questions, please contact us.
- 8. <u>Can you administer medication?</u> Please contact us to discuss your medication needs.
- 9. What does it cost for my child to attend the center? Our center is FREE thanks to donations provided by businesses and community members.
- 10. <u>Can my child participate in the Teen Leader program?</u> Grades 6-9 meet monthly to help organize events in the community. Contact us if you are interested.
- 11. <u>Can you make sure my child completes their homework?</u> We are here to provide assistance as needed. Please encourage your child to schedule their time appropriately.
- 12. <u>Can my child use a phone?</u> Yes, of course your child may use our center phone to contact you at any time.
- 13. <u>Do you have WiFi?</u> Yes, we have internet usage for all students. We also have a few computers, with safety controls set, for the students to use for homework or games.
